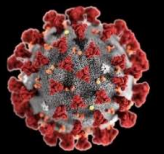

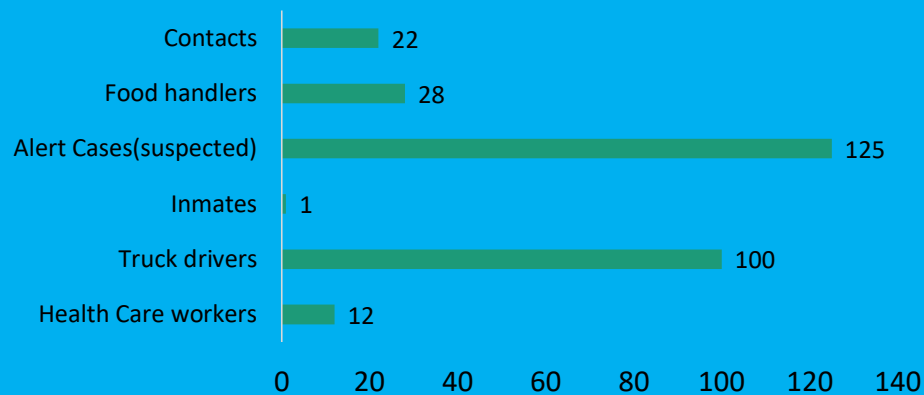
## Positive Cases By Gender

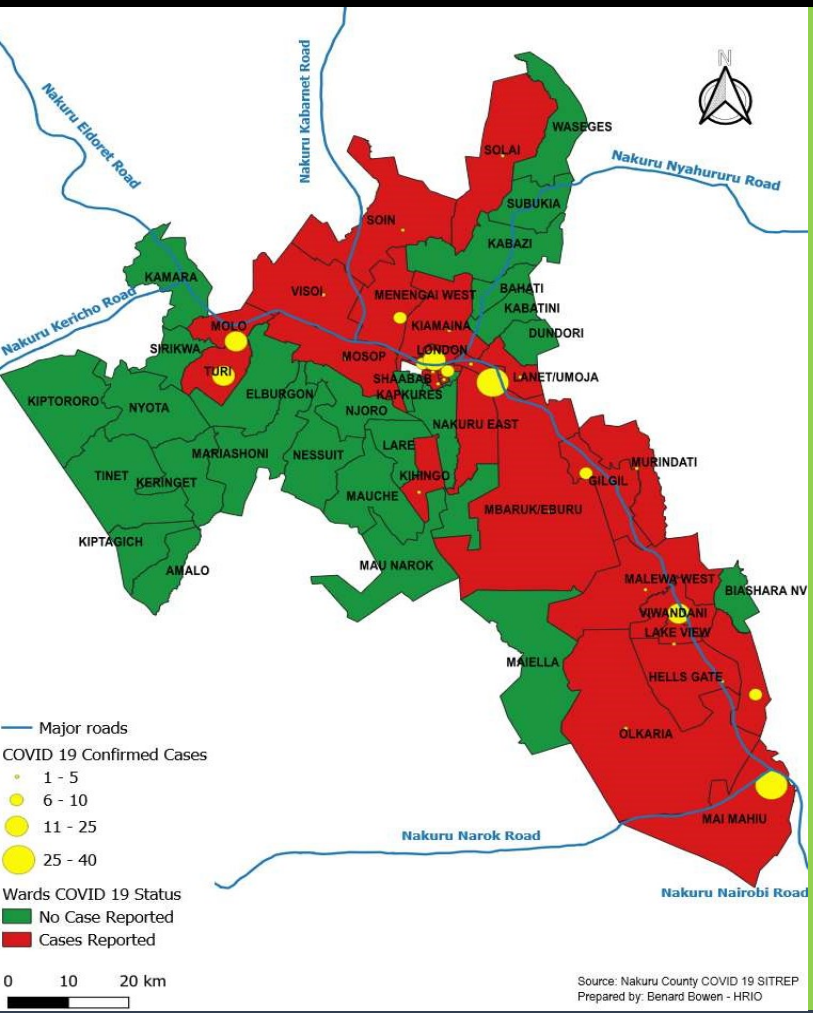

Only Kuresoi South Sub county has no confirmed case

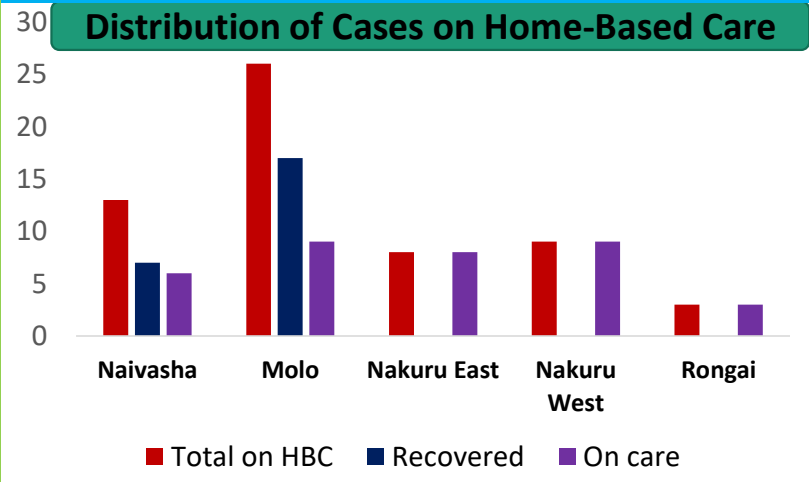
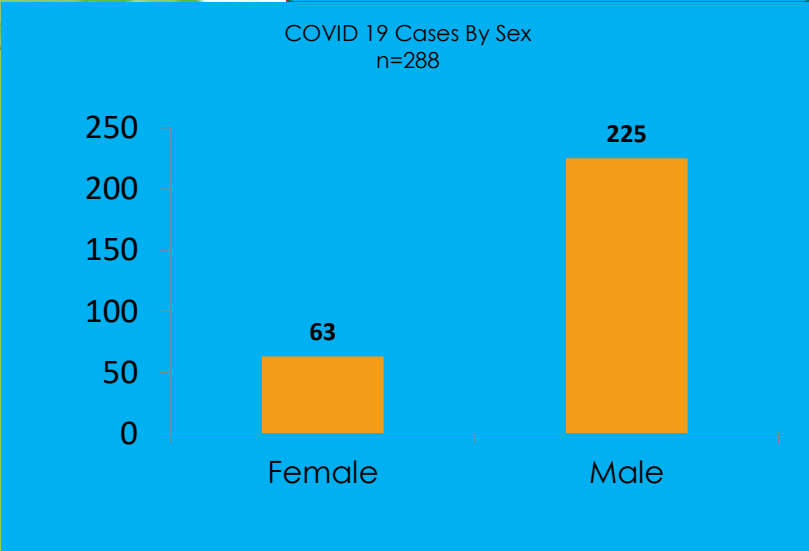
21 Wards out of 55 wards have a positive case

74% of cases have been detected with the county residents while those from outside the county contributing to 26%

Mai Mahiu town, Naivasha Viwandani ward , Kikopy, Turi, Nakuru East Biashara ward, Saalga and mau summit are the current hot spots

Transmission is concentrated along words along the highway

Institution and guest house have positive cases ( Molo and Rongai)
