Engineering; Motor Vehicle and Mechanics, Carpentry and Joinery; Clothing Technology; from a recognized institution

OR

Have KCSE 'D-' and Craft or Trade Test Grade I certificate in any of the following disciplines: Electronics Engineering; Welding and Fabrication, Metal Processing; Electrical Engineering; Motor Vehicle and Mechanics, Carpentry and Joinery; Clothing Technology; from a recognized institution

- iii. Have an Instructors' course (MANDATORY);
- iv. Have a Certificate in basic Computer Application from a recognized institution.

Duties and Responsibilities

This is the entry and training grade for the Vocational Training Instructors with diploma qualifications. An Instructor at this level will work under the guidance of a senior Instructor.

- ii. Preparing and maintaining schemes of work, lesson plans, lesson notes, trainee records, training and learning materials;

- v. Conducting co-curricular activities and maintaining trainees' discipline; and
