A report on public participation held on 19th June, 2024 at Rhonda Ward.

The objective of the Governor's neighborhood engagement Initiative is to prioritize residents' views and concerns in the urban development and decision-making processes. The following were the key priority proposals:

- 1. Acquisition of land for expansion of Ponda Mali market
- 2. Tarmacking of the road from Ponda Mali to CK
- 3. Resolve Ponda Mali market land ownership dispute with Kenya Pipeline
- 4. Support youth through provision of incentives to start business
- 5. During the construction of a new market, partition the sections according to industry e.g. Jua Kali, Carpentry, Groceries etc.
- 6. Improve sanitation within Ponda Mali market by installing drainage covers
- 7. Set aside a budget for maintenance and operationalization of infrastructural projects e.g. unclogging of drainages
- 8. Road marking and installation of bumps from *Kanja square* to *KK*
- 9. Completion of Mbugua Mbugua drainage works especially at Mwariki Primary school to curb flooding in neighborhood estates
- 10. Installation of floodlights at Mandizii
- 11. Construction of market sheds at Ponda Mali market
- 12. Rehabilitation of the road from *CK- Ponda Mali- Sewage- Kahoto road (Mzee wa Maji)-Game park Ndarugu River*.
- 13. Ensure gender equality and consideration in job allocation.
- 14. Provision of age friendly infrastructure e.g. washrooms, rams, Baby sitting facilities etc.
- 15. Construction of physiotherapy centres for kids
- 16. Deployment of a City Ambulance to respond to emergencies
- 17. Allocation of land for social amenities e.g. churches
- 18. Inclusion of cottage industries during market construction.
- 19. Ensure equity in allocation of market spaces. 5% should be allocated to PWDs
