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A report on public participation held on 10th November 2023 at Kapkures chief's office – convener area MCA

The objective of the meeting was aligned with H.E the Governor's agenda to tour the wards within the City and seek citizens' opinions on development priorities. The manager introduced the City technical team after which he requested members of the public to highlight their plight and recommend solutions.

The following are some of the suggestions:

1. Upgrade Kapkures Health Centre to a level 4 hospital on a 3.6-acre piece of land that is up for sale.
2. Acquire 5.4 acres of land at a cost of 60 million for the construction of a stadium.
3. Increase water supply and ensure it meets WHO standards. Currently, residents use borehole water that is contaminated. There has been no piped water for the last 3 years.
4. Acquire land for the construction of an ECDE school. The nearest school is 5km away, risking the lives of pupils.
5. Tarmac link roads, including Kapkures-Mogoon-Ingobor Centre road, Tech Farm-Upper Hill road, Kapkures Centre through Kapkures Primary to Ingobor Centre.
6. Acquire land for construction of a market.
7. Construct a boarding school in the area.
8. Connect to a sewer system as opposed to using pit latrines.
9. Construct a proper water drainage system.
10. Provide an industrial power system to avoid frequent power outages during rainy seasons.
11. Construct agro-processing plants in the area.
12. Construct and furnish a social hall.
13. Provide housing for the area chiefs.
14. Ensure equity in the engagement of casual workers in County jobs.
15. Provide sanitary pads to school girls.
16. Consider women during tender awards.
17. Waive fees on the renewal of business permits.
18. Acquire land for the construction of a dumpsite.
19. Provide an ambulance to serve Kapkures Health Centre.
20. Consideration in the last mile electricity connectivity.
21. Solarize the existing borehole due to high electricity costs.

Finally the residents expressed their gratitude to H.E the Governor for effective service delivery and requested that she schedules a visit to the area.
