Report on Public Participation: Identification of Ward Projects

Ward: Lakeview Ward, Naivasha Municipality

Date: 3rd April 2024

Introduction

This report provides a summary of the public participation exercise conducted on 3rd April 2024 in Lakeview Ward at the Municipal Chambers, Naivasha Municipality. The exercise aimed to involve community stakeholders in prioritizing developmental projects to enhance the ward's growth and address specific local challenges.

Attendance

The forum was attended by a wide range of stakeholders, including:

- Community members and leaders
- Local government representatives
- Civil society organizations
- Municipal technical teams

Projects Identified

The public discussions highlighted several priority projects, as outlined below:

- 1. Urban Greening of Kenyatta Avenue Strip**
 - **Objective:** Enhance environmental sustainability and improve the aesthetic value of the area.
 - **Activities Proposed:**
 - Planting trees and shrubs along the avenue.
 - Installing street furniture such as benches and litter bins.
 - Conducting regular maintenance and landscaping.
- 2. Non-Motorized Transport (NMT) Infrastructure**
 - **Objective:** Promote safe and inclusive mobility for pedestrians and cyclists.
 - **Activities Proposed:**
 - Constructing walkways and bicycle lanes especially in the recently tarmacked lakeview estate roads.

- Installing proper lighting and signage as the neighbourhood doesn't have any currently
 - 3. **Paving of Roads**
 - **Objective:** Improve accessibility and reduce dust pollution especially in Kayole locality as it does have any tarmac road with exception to A8 highway
 - **Priority Roads:**
 - Access roads to residential and commercial areas.
 - Roads connecting Lakeview Ward to other wards.
 - 4. **Lake Riparian Conservation Project**
 - **Objective:** Protect and rehabilitate the riparian areas around Lake Naivasha especially in Kihoto locality.
 - **Proposals:**
 - Conducting awareness campaigns on riparian zone regulations.
 - Planting indigenous vegetation to stabilize soil and prevent erosion.
 - 5. **Solid Waste Management Initiative**
 - **Objective:** Improve waste disposal and maintain cleanliness in public spaces.
 - **Activities:**
 - Setting up waste collection points.
 - Introducing community-driven clean-up initiatives.
 - 6. **Expansion of Health and Education Facilities**
 - **Objective:** Address the growing demand for health and education services.
 - **Proposals:**
 - Constructing new classrooms in existing schools as the CBC is being implemented thus pressuring the already overstretched public schools i.e Milimani Primary schools which .has a population of 4,500 pupils others schools include Lakeview Primary School which has a population of around 3000 pupils
 - Expanding Lakeview's health center to include specialized services.
 - 7. **Public Recreational Spaces**
 - **Objective:** Provide safe spaces for leisure and community interaction.
 - **Proposals:**
 - Rehabilitation of Kenyatta Gardens and other play grounds especially in Kihoto informal settlement.

Key Recommendations

- Focus on community engagement during project implementation.
- Leverage public-private partnerships for funding and technical support.
- Ensure timely monitoring and evaluation to track project progress.

Conclusion

The public participation exercise demonstrated a strong commitment to sustainable and inclusive development in Lakeview Ward. The identified projects reflect the community's priorities and align with Naivasha Municipality's broader urban development goals.
