**MIN 2/20/08/2024: PRESENTATION OF ADP FY 2025/2026**

**2.1 Infrastructure Sector**

**Key Priority Areas Identified:**

- Storm water management
- Maintenance and rehabilitation of roads
- Installation of streetlights
- Installation of culverts, drifts, and footpaths

### **Specific Proposals from the Public:**

- Construction of drainage from NYS to the main river.
- Construction and clearing of storm water drainages in Mbegi, Milimani, Ngomongo, and other affected areas.
- Installation of culverts in flood-prone areas.
- Grading and murraming of roads across wards.
- Installation of high mast streetlights in trading centres and residential areas.
- Construction of footpaths and drifts to improve accessibility.

### **Key Concerns Raised:**

- Frequent flooding during rainy seasons.
  - Poor road network affecting transport and business operations.
  - Insecurity due to inadequate street lighting.

## **2.2 Education Sector**

### **Priority Area:**

- Early Childhood Development Education (ECDE)

### **Proposed Intervention:**

- Construction and equipping of ECDE classrooms, particularly in Malewa West Ward.

### **Issues Raised:**

- Inadequate ECDE infrastructure.
  - Need for improved learning facilities and teaching equipment.

## **2.3 Water Sector**

### **Priority Area:**

- Piping and distribution of water.

### **Proposed Intervention:**

- Expansion of water piping and distribution systems in Malewa West and other underserved areas.

### **Issues Raised:**

- Water shortages and unreliable supply.
- Need for equitable distribution of water infrastructure.

**MIN 3/20/08/2024: PUBLIC VIEWS&RESOLUTIONS**

- Development projects should be equitably distributed across all wards.
- Flood-prone areas should be prioritized under infrastructure development.
- Timely implementation and proper supervision of projects were emphasized.

2. Road maintenance and rehabilitation be enhanced across wards.
3. Street lighting projects be expanded to improve security.
4. Construction and equipping of ECDE classrooms be prioritized.
5. Water distribution projects be incorporated into the ADP subject to budget availability and technical feasibility.



**PUBLIC PARTICIPATION REPORT ON THE PREPARATION OF ANNUAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN HELD ON 20<sup>TH</sup> AUG, 2024 AT FOREST HALL-GILGIL TOWN**

**1. INTRODUCTION**

This report presents the outcomes of the Public Participation Forum conducted to collect views from residents of **Gilgil Municipality** to inform the preparation of the Annual Development Plan (ADP) for the Financial Year 2025/2026.

Public participation is undertaken in compliance with the Constitution of Kenya (2010), the Public Finance Management Act (2012), and other relevant legal frameworks that require citizen involvement in planning and budgeting processes

**2. Objective of the Forum**

The main objective of the forum was to:

- Present the proposed ADP priorities for FY 2025/2026.
- Provide an opportunity for residents and stakeholders to submit their development priorities.
- Ensure that community needs are incorporated into the County planning framework.

**3. Summary of public views and departmental responses**

Members of the public raised key development concerns mainly in infrastructure, education, and water sectors. The major issues included frequent flooding due to inadequate storm water drainage, poor road conditions, insecurity caused by insufficient street lighting, inadequate ECDE classrooms, and unreliable water supply in some areas.

The technical teams acknowledged the concerns and informed the forum that storm water management, road rehabilitation, installation of streetlights, construction and equipping of ECDE classrooms, and expansion of water distribution networks would be prioritized in the FY 2025/2026 ADP, subject to budget availability and technical feasibility.

#### **4. Key observations**

- There is a strong demand for infrastructure improvements, particularly drainage and roads.
- Equitable distribution of projects across wards emphasized
- Community members requested timely implementation and proper supervision of projects.

#### **5. Conclusion**

The Public Participation Forum successfully provided residents with an opportunity to contribute to the County planning process. The issues raised reflects the community priority needs, particularly in infrastructure, education and water sources. The views collected will be reviewed and integrated into the final ADP FY 2025/2026.

**MIN 1/07/10/2024: PRELIMINARIES**

The meeting commenced with a word of prayer led by one of the traders. The chairperson welcomed all members present and thanked them for attending the meeting. The purpose of the meeting was explained as addressing the grievances raised by traders operating within the market.

**MIN 2/07/10/2024: SECURITY IN THE MARKET**

Traders raised several complaints regarding insecurity within the market. The following issues were highlighted:

- Many traders complained about goods being stolen from their stalls.
- A melon dealer reported that his fruits were destroyed and sliced into pieces by unknown persons the previous day.
- Complaints were raised about tomatoes being stolen from stalls.
- Cases of onions being stolen were also reported.
- Food vendors reported that some of their utensils had been stolen.

Traders expressed concern that the increasing cases of theft are affecting their businesses and causing financial losses.

MIN 3/07/10/2024: COMMUNICATION

Traders expressed dissatisfaction with the lack of effective communication between the market management and the traders. They noted that many concerns raised by traders are not addressed on time.

**Resolution:**

Authorities were urged to improve communication channels between traders and market administration to ensure timely handling of issues.

MIN 4/07/10/2024: RESOLUTION BY TRADERS

After deliberations, traders unanimously agreed on the following:

1. Traders will not be ready to pay market revenue until further notice if the security situation is not addressed.
2. No payments for goods or parcels will be made until the issue is resolved.
3. Neither vehicle charges nor small parcel fees will be paid until the security concerns are addressed.

**MIN 1/31/01/2025: PRELIMINARIES**

The meeting commenced at 10:30 A.M. with a word of prayer led by a community representative. The Municipal Manager welcomed members of the public and thanked them for attending the forum aimed at gathering public views on the preparation of the County Fiscal Strategy Paper (CFSP) for the MTEF period 2025/2026–2027/2028.

Participants introduced themselves and indicated the wards and groups they represented. The technical team from the municipality and relevant county departments also introduced themselves.

The Chairperson of the Gilgil Municipal Board emphasized the importance of public participation in the county planning and budgeting process as provided for under the Constitution of Kenya and the Public Finance Management Act. He encouraged residents to actively share their views and development priorities to ensure that county resources are allocated to projects that address community needs.

The Municipal Manager thereafter invited the Economist to make a presentation on the County Fiscal Strategy Paper and the proposed sector priorities for the upcoming MTEF period.

## MIN 2/31/01/2025: PRESENTATION OF THE SECTOR REPORT

The Economist informed the participants that the County Fiscal Strategy Paper (CFSP) is a key document that outlines the county's fiscal priorities and guides the preparation of the annual county budget.

The presentation highlighted:

- The county's revenue outlook and expenditure priorities
- Key development programmes proposed for the MTEF period 2025/2026–2027/2028
- The importance of aligning county priorities with sustainable development and climate resilience

The participants were also taken through the major sector focus areas, including infrastructure development, water services, early childhood education, environmental management, and urban services.

In addition, the technical team emphasized the need to incorporate climate change adaptation measures, particularly in areas prone to flooding and environmental degradation within the municipality.

Members of the public were encouraged to provide proposals that would help the county government prioritize projects that improve service delivery and promote economic development

## MIN 3/31/01/2025: REACTIONS & PLENARY

During the plenary session, members of the public raised several issues affecting residents within Gilgil Municipality.

### **Infrastructure and Drainage**

Residents raised concerns about poor drainage systems, especially in areas prone to flooding during the rainy season. They requested the municipality to prioritize storm water drainage improvement and road maintenance.

#### **Response:**

The technical team acknowledged the concerns and noted that improvement of drainage systems would be considered in future infrastructure planning.

---

### **Street Lighting and Security**

Members proposed the installation of additional streetlights in residential areas and trading centres to enhance security and support economic activities during evening hours.

**Response:**

The municipality noted the proposal and indicated that street lighting projects would be prioritized subject to budget availability.

**Water Supply**

Participants highlighted challenges related to inadequate water supply in some parts of the municipality, particularly in newly developing areas.

**Response:**

The team informed residents that expansion of water distribution infrastructure would be explored in collaboration with the relevant county department and water service provider

**Education and Youth Development**

Residents proposed the construction and improvement of ECDE classrooms as well as support for youth empowerment programmes, including skills development initiatives.

**Response:**

The proposals were acknowledged and residents were encouraged to continue engaging in public participation forums to help prioritize such projects.

**Environmental Conservation and Climate Action**

Participants stressed the need for the county government to promote environmental conservation measures, including:

- Tree planting initiatives
- Protection of riverbanks
- Proper waste management within the municipality

**Response:**

The technical team confirmed that environmental sustainability and climate action initiatives are important considerations in county development planning.

The Municipal Manager thanked members of the public for their active participation and valuable contributions.

He informed participants that all issues and proposals raised during the forum would be documented and forwarded to the relevant county departments for consideration during the finalization of the County Fiscal Strategy Paper and the subsequent budgeting process.

Members of the public were encouraged to continue participating in future planning and budgeting forums in order to ensure that development initiatives reflect community priorities.

There being no other business, the meeting was adjourned at 2:30 P.M.
